Re: HASLEMERE MUSEUM TRIP - Wednesday 20 November 2024

We are pleased to let you know that we have made arrangements for the Year 1 to visit Haslemere Museum to support our topic next half term on 'Childhood from long ago'. The visit will include a workshop on toys from the past, where children will have the opportunity to play with and explore toys, understand how materials for making toys has changed and discuss similarities and differences with modern day toys.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform as normal. Please can you provide a lunch for your child, including two fruit / vegetable snacks, along with a water bottle as normal in a sensibly sized bag that your child can carry and be responsible for. Pupils will not be excluded from the visit because parents are not in a position to contribute, but as we are not able to fund the activity in any other way it will be cancelled unless we cover costs.
