WHAT WE HAVE BEEN UP TO THIS WEEK

YEAR 1 - Thursday saw Year 1 head to Brooklands Museum as part of their transport topic. The children and staff throughly enjoyed exploring and learning all about a variety of modes of transport, along with having great fun creating 'peg racers' and 'loopy gliders'. A huge thank you to all our volunteers who supported the children throughout the day. We hope you enjoyed the visit as much as the children did.



YEAR 3 - During DT the children have been learning how to create pneumatic systems using syringes, tubes and balloons in preparation of their 'monster' project. This element of the project will allow them to bring their monsters to life. The children enjoyed learning how to use compressed air to make objects move. We will, of course, share their finished products with you over the weeks ahead.



YEAR 5 - The children have been working in pairs during their PE lesson to create and perform a dance linked to feelings when providing feedback. They looked at the work of American dancer and choreographer Merce Cunningham and then went on to create their own 'Dance by Chance' composition. PARKING IN AND AROUND OUR SCHOOL - Please can we remind all parents/carers of the importance of parking safely around our school site. We wanted to remind everyone that the area circled in the picture to the right, as you drive into Jordans Close (the garages and slip road), is **private parking for residents only**. The yellow roads highlighted are council maintained roads. The 'red' area is maintained by a private company and they are able to clamp/issue fines which they will be doing from Monday.

We would also like to remind everyone of the Highway Code rule which states that drivers **should not park within 10 metres of a junction** except in an authorised parking space. Currently cars are parking at both the junctions of The Greenwood and Beatty Avenue which is causing problems for both residents and parents/carers.
