Our LEARNING

Our plans for the week ahead:



Phonics

Please continue to read at least 3 times a week at home. Practise the green and red words in the front of your story books and record in your child's reading diary when you are reading at home!

PSHE

This week we will be discussing independence in daily tasks. We will look at tasks that they can achieve independently and ones that they may need support with.

Maths

This week we will continue to look at addition and subtraction. We will practise recording as number sentences.

Understanding the world

Expressive Arts and Design
