SATs Week

Starting on Monday 11 May, all Year 6 children nationwide will complete their SATs. The timetable, for your information is:

- Monday: English Punctuation, Spelling and Grammar (SPAG)
- Tuesday: English Reading
- Wednesday: Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic) and Paper 2 (Reasoning)
- Thursday: Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning)

The children will complete their papers in the mornings. Please ensure that your child arrives at school punctually at 8:35 each day and has eaten breakfast. Other than that, we try not to put a lot of emphasis on the SATs for the children and aim to keep the week as calm, relaxed and normal as possible. We know that all the children will do their best and we reassure them that this is all we ask of them.

In the event of illness, the best way to deal with minor ailments (sore throat, runny nose, tummy ache etc.), is for your child to come to school, sit the test(s) and then go straight home and get better for the next day. Please contact the School Office on the morning of the test should anything be wrong and we can try to make the best possible arrangements for you and your child.

There will be no swimming sessions on Thursday 14.

Water Fight: Friday 15 May

The annual water fight is always a highlight for Year 6, and is a great way to let off steam once the SATs are all completed! This year, we have scheduled the water fight for the afternoon of Friday 15 May.

All children should wear PE kit on Friday morning. If they wish to take part in the water fight, they should bring in a complete set of clothes and shoes that they don't mind getting wet. **They must bring a swimsuit to wear underneath these clothes.** They may also bring in a water pistol to use and will need to have **a towel** to dry off afterwards. After the water fight, we will share a snack with the children.

If the weather is really bad on the day, and we feel that the children will get too cold, we will postpone, but the weather is currently looking promising for next week.
