

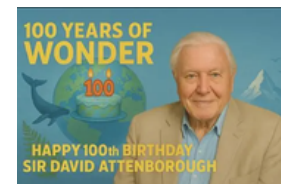


A MESSAGE FROM MRS FITCH AND MRS STACEY

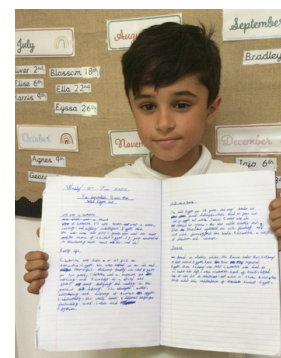


WHAT WE HAVE BEEN UP TO THIS WEEK...
