- Milk can be ordered and paid for online. Please ask at the school office for details.

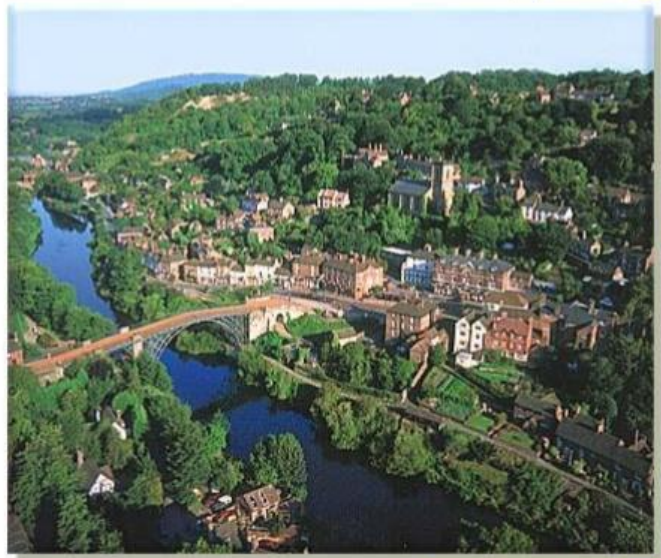
Year 5 swimming day is Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a named swimming kit.

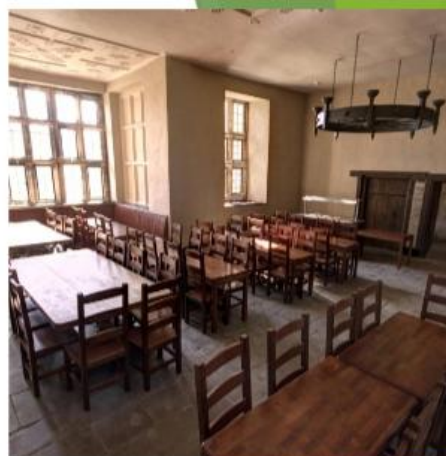
